NEW PUBLENEF REPORTS ON GOOD PRACTICE AND NEEDS ASSESSMENTS FOR ENERGY EFFICIENCY POLICIES AT NATIONAL, REGIONAL AND LOCAL LEVEL

The main purpose of the Publenef project is to support national, regional and local authorities in implementing useful sustainable energy policies by showcasing of the best practices from other Member States. In the early phase of the Project the comprehensive research on needs and good examples of energy efficiency policies implemented on each administrative level has been performed and the outcomes have been presented in new Publenef Reports.

The Publenef Report on <u>Good practices case studies</u> compiles an inventory of Top 20 Good Practices in energy efficiency policies as a result of SWOT analysis. These Top 20 have been selected from 55 examples identified through questionnaires distributed by each partner among their national stakeholders.

The analysis, evaluation and prioritization of public bodies needs at various administrative levels resulted in **Compilation of needs assessment Report**. This Report provides public authorities with information on short-falls in existing energy efficiency policies.

The study of the responses have resulted in determining what factors are driving the success or failure of such actions and how they can be replicated according to identified realistic needs of energy efficiency policymakers.

In further stages of the project these Top 20 good practices together with useful tools collected will be matched with the common needs expressed by policymakers and finally the roadmaps will be built and implemented in each of countries represented by project partners.
